A guide for patients

This leaflet should only be used by specific individuals following testing at the Practice. Please contact the Hospital Consultant Secretary for any tests results which have been requested by the Hospital.
NOTE: We are unable to share information for a young person over the age of 12 unless consent has been provided for access to their information. This includes parents of children 12 years and over without their express consent.

A guide to your test results

GP (General Practitioner)
Consultation or Hospital request - Patient advised to attend Practice for tests

You have been assessed by your GP/Hospital and he/she has asked for you to attend the Practice for tests.
During your consultation your PN (Practice Nurse), HCA (Health Care Assistant) or Phlebotomist will explain why the test is being requested.

I've had a test taken - what happens now?

Your test will be sent onto the labs. Your GP will receive back the results and from the information he/she will comment on any action required and record details in your medical record.
He/she may contact you directly to confirm the result or alternatively someone else may call to inform you of any action required. **The Practice will only contact you if action is required.**

How long will I need to wait to get my test results and how do I get my result?

If you wish to enquire about your results, you can call the Practice from seven working days after your test to receive the test result.
However some specific tests do take a bit longer - you will be advised of this during your consultation.
