You have been assessed by yo GP/Hospital and he/she has asl for you to attend the Practice fo tests.

During your consultation your P (Practice Nurse), HCA_(Health Assistant) or Phlebotomist will explain why the test is being requested.

I've had a test taken – what happens now?

Your test will be sent onto the la Your GP will receive back the results and from the information /she will comment on any action required and record details in your medical record.

He/she may contact you directly confirm the result or alternatively someone else may call to inform of any action required. The Praction only contact you if action required.

How long will I need to wait to get my test results and how do I get my result?

If you wish to enquire about you results, you can call the Practice from seven working days after y test to receive the test result. However some specific tests do a bit longer – you will be advised this during your consultation.

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
